



LSJ Dance COVID - 19 Protocols

LSJ Dance is aware of the recent announcement by the Governor of Texas. As always, the health and safety of our dancers, teachers, and staff is of utmost importance therefore at LSJ Dance we will continue to follow Health Protocols suggested by the CDC and that we have had in place this season. The protocols in place have allowed LSJ to operate while keeping a safe environment and have allowed our dancers to remain in person for classes and competitions throughout the season.

Please review the following guidelines we will be following.

Studio Operations:

- Upon entering the studio, we will do a non-contact temperature check of each dancer. Any dancer with a temperature of 100 or higher will not be permitted to stay for the lesson. Parents, please wait to get a thumbs up from your child before leaving the premises.
- The lobby will remain closed at this time. (Exception: Dancers 5 and under may have one adult in the lobby during their lesson. Parents will be asked to use proper social distancing protocols, wear a mask when social distancing is not possible while their child is in their dance lesson, and be available if there is a needed restroom break for their dancer. Please make sure you have a mask available as dancers come in to prepare for their next lesson.)
- All dancers in classes with age 10 and older dancers will need a mask. Dancers, guests and staff will still wear their masks in the lobby and in the studio when they are unable to follow social distancing guidelines. Dancers will be allowed to pull down or remove their masks while dancing away from others, however if they are dancing in close proximity to others or working in close formations they will be asked to put on their mask in class.
- Hand Sanitizer will be provided upon entry and is available for use in all of the studio rooms.
- We will be opening up our break/homework room. Dancers must social distance and/or wear masks while waiting in the lobby or in the break room.
- The water fountain will be closed at this time. Please make sure dancers have their own water or have a water card on file to purchase disposable water bottles from the office. Water cards are \$10 for ten water bottles.
- Class sizes will be limited, and if needed, classes may be split into two different times to allow for everyone to participate.
- Staff will wipe down all high contact areas between each class. The entire studio will be sanitized each evening, and will undergo a deep cleaning by a professional cleaning crew each week.
- Acro/Tumbling classes will use the mats. Students will have designated areas for conditioning and center work. Tumbling teachers will be spotting students. Masks will be worn and sanitizer will be provided throughout the class. Mats and materials will be sprayed and cleaned after they are used.
