



LSJ Dance COVID - 19 Protocols

Studio Operations:

- Dancers will wait outside until a teacher or staff member comes to let dancers into the studio.
- At the door we will do a non-contact temperature check. Any dancer with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted to stay for the lesson. Parents, please wait to get a thumbs up from your child before leaving the premises.
- The lobby will be closed at this time. (Exception: Dancers 5 and under may have one adult in the lobby during their lesson. Parents will be asked to use proper social distancing protocols, wear a mask while their child is in their dance lesson, and be available if there is a needed restroom break for their dancer.)
- Per the governor's orders, anyone entering the dance studio (age 10 and up) will need a mask. Dancers and staff will wear their masks in the lobby and in class when they are unable to follow social distancing guidelines. Dancers will take frequent breaks to spread apart, breathe, and hydrate.
- Hand Sanitizer will be provided upon entry and is available for use in all of the studio rooms.
- Dancers will only need to bring a small bag with dance shoes and water into the studio. There will be designated areas (6ft apart) for dancers to place their belongings.
- The break room will be closed at this time. If a dancer has a break between classes they will be allowed to wait in our lobby. Dancers must social distance and wear masks while waiting in the lobby.
- The water fountain will be closed at this time. Please make sure dancers have their own water or have a water card on file to purchase disposable water bottles from the office.
- The dance floors in each room will be marked with at least 6 feet distance to remind dancers to stay 6 feet apart.
- Class sizes will be limited, and if needed, classes may be split into two different times to allow for everyone to participate.
- Staff will wipe down all high contact areas between each class. The entire studio will be thoroughly cleaned each evening, and will undergo a deep cleaning by a professional cleaning crew each week.
- Acro/Tumbling classes will use the mats. Students will have designated areas for conditioning and center work. Tumbling teachers will be spotting students. Masks will be worn and sanitizer will be provided throughout the class. Mats and materials will be sprayed and cleaned between each class.
- Dancers will be dismissed from classes individually or in small groups to avoid students congregating.
